

P.E. and School Sport Grant – 2018/19

The allocation for Abbey Court for 2018/19 is expected to be £16,537 in total (payable in 2 parts; 7/12's (£9,645) in October 2018 and 5/12's (£6,892) in April 2019). This figure incorporates the recent Government amendment to allocation for schools.

From our analysis of whole school performance data the following targets have been set:

- ✓ **Primary department to achieve:-**
 - 19 swimming awards**
 - 6 gymnastic awards**
 - 5 Rebound Therapy awards**
 - 10 Horse riding/Tonto awards**

PE and Sport premium action plan

Abbey Court's continuing aim is to ensure a lasting legacy of high quality PE and Sport throughout the school (all Key Stages), with additional funding from the schools own resources, to fund the appointment of a specialist PE teacher and a replacement specialist PE assistant (to be appointed during the academic year) in order to;

- ✓ Lead training to increase the subject knowledge and teaching skills of staff. The end of the year PE subject evaluation will identify the impact of training that staff have engaged in.
- ✓ Organising and facilitating sport competitions between schools. The end of year PE subject evaluation will identify the sports competitions that pupils have participated in, and the number of pupils that have participated (with a view to increasing future participation).
- ✓ Linking learning activities to National and International sporting events such as, the Tour de France, Winter Olympics and Football World Cup. The end of year PE subject evaluation will identify the in school themed sports events that have taken place.
- ✓ To increase the participation and subsequent accreditation of pupils achievements. The results of the pupil progress and attainment targets will evaluate the success of this target.
- ✓ To promote pupils health and well-being. (Pupil progress meetings consider individual pupil access to additional sports opportunities reference pupil behaviour; obesity; high achievers in PE and those under-performing (R.I.)). The notes of pupil progress meetings will identify particular interventions for specific pupils and the progress/impact of these opportunities.
- ✓ To consolidate and embed the requirements for the Gold Sportsmark Award achieved in July 2018.
