The Creative Arts are also taught through other areas of the FE Curriculum, including Leisure and Recreation, Environmental and Outside Learning, Languages and through Multi-Cultural Events/Theme Days. Additionally, students' music learning is supported by the use of ICT/Computing equipment. Selected students are supported during 1:1 sessions with a specialist Music teacher. Students' art skills are developed through Enterprise Education projects. Students' drama skills are developed through the use of role play, which is used to support students' understanding and learning in many areas of the curriculum, including PSHE, SRE, Health Education, Community Learning, travel training and Numeracy and Literacy. Drama allows students the opportunities to explore ideas and practise new skills, in addition to developing their communication skills and confidence, in a 'safe' environment, before students transfer this learning into real-life contexts.
